DIRECTIONS FOR USE

BEFORE APPLYING

1) Determine your grass type to choose the correct fertilizer. If help is needed to determine grass type, visit tri-linksolutions.com/allseasons

 Select appropriate product according to season – Step 1: Spring Application, Step 2: Summer Application, Step 3: Fall Application, USE ON ESTABLISHED LAWNS.

3) Determine the application area of your lawn. Subtract any non-lawn areas within that application area.

Each pail covers approximately 5.000 square feet.

WHEN TO APPLY

1) Apply STEP 1 during the Spring, apply STEP 2 in Summer, and apply STEP 3 during Fall. Each STEP provides season-long nutrition.

2) Apply when the grass foliage is dry. If possible, water lawn following fertilizer application. Keep children and pets out until lawn is dry.

HOW TO APPLY AND AMOUNT

1) Set spreader to approximate setting as shown in the chart below. These settings are for applying 3 lbs of product per 1,000 sq ft. APPLY APPROPRIATE PRODUCT ONCE PER SEASON.

2) Fill your spreader on a stable area, away from your lawn. Apply only to actively growing turf. Do not apply near water, storm drains, or drainage ditches. Do not apply if heavy rain is expected. Apply this product only to your lawn, and sweep any product that lands in driveway, sidewalk, or street, back onto your lawn. Check with your local Cooperative Extension Agency to obtain specific information on local turf best management practices. Check with your county or city government to determine if there are local regulations for fertilizer use.

 Start by spreading fertilizer around the border of the lawn. Then make even. parallel passes across your lawn spaced according to spreader specifications. Walk at a steady pace to maintain consistent spread rate.
